LET IT BE REMEMBERED the Collier County Tourist Development Council, in and for the County of Collier, having conducted business herein, met on this date 9:00 a.m. in REGULAR SESSION at 33299 Tamiami Trail East, 3rd floor, Naples, FL 34112 with the following members present:

1. Call to order and Roll Call

Mr. Melleky called the meeting to order.

A quorum of four was established by those members present in the room.

2. Pledge of Allegiance

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

3. Approval of Agenda

Ms. Beyrent made a motion to approve the agenda. Mr. Gower seconded the motion. The motion was carried unanimously, 4-0.

4. Approval of Minutes

Ms. Beyrent made a motion to approve the minutes. Ms. De Caro seconded the motion. The motion was carried with a vote of 4-0.

5. Staff Report

Mr. Melleky announced arts and culture grants were approved at the Board of County Commissioners on September 23, 2025. There were 18 grants awarded, which is the most in the history of the program, and totaled \$770,000. The artist notecards were displayed for the Call to Artists.

Mr. Melleky has been finalizing the iARTE VIVA schedule, and a press conference has been scheduled for October 1 at 10 am at Gulfshore Playhouse. The poster has been finalized and is in final production for the press conference.

Mr. Melleky displayed the prototype for the Tourism Star Awards, which will most likely take place in May of 2026.

6. Public Comments

There were no public comments.

7. New Business

a. Committee Member selection

The committee selected officers.

Mr. Gower moved to approve Nora Beyerent as Chair and Muffy Clark Gill as Vice Chair. Ms. DeCaro seconded, and the motion passed unanimously, 4-0.

b. Meeting Dates

Ms. Kerwin arrived, bringing the vote count total to be 5.

The meeting dates were discussed, and it was recommended to hold meetings every other month in odd-numbered months, on the fourth Wednesday of the month. November's meeting will be held on the third Wednesday due to the holiday. The July meeting was cancelled as many of the committee members travel during that month.

Ms. DeCaro moved to approve the meeting dates. Ms. Absher seconded and the motion passed unanimously, 5-0.

c. Possible future public art project

Mr. Melleky discussed a meeting with a resident on Isle of Capri seeking assistance on a possible statue of dolphins near a county park. The resident was going to research a variety of options for the placement of the statue.

d. Notecard Themes for 2026

The committee discussed possible themes for the notecard program for 2026. The committee agreed on Flora and Fauna as a theme.

8. Old Business

There was no old business.

9. Advisory Board Member Discussion

Other public art pieces were noted by the committee:

- Humane Society entrance mural in mosaic
- Resin beach artwork at Naples Airport.

The committee suggested working with United Arts Collier to create a public art show in various locations to show public art and to perhaps use some public or private spaces.

Mr. Gower mentioned a City of Naples workshop on October 13 regarding the use of public spaces for arts and the associated costs of utilizing and securing those spaces.

Ms. Kerwin requested a review of the public art form flowchart.

10. Next Meeting- Wednesday, November 19, 2025, at 3:00 pm at the Tourism office

There being no further business for the good of the County, the meeting was adjourned by Ms. Beyrent at 4:05 P.M.

Notecards

The Naples CVB provides various items to promote the destination. The organization wants to identify two local artists to provide two images of their artwork for use in a pack of four notecards. The note cards will be 5 in x 7 in size. Local artists are further defined under the eligibility requirements. These are distributed at trade shows, gift baskets, and other giveaways. The gift cards will not be sold.



The notecard program will select two artists each year, to create a tradition of notecards that promote the art and artists of Florida's Paradise Coast.

2026 Notecard Theme

The theme for the 2026 Notecards is **Flora and Fauna** of Florida's Paradise Coast. We are home to beautiful natural scenes and are seeking artwork that represents plant and/or animal life throughout Collier County.

Eligibility

- Artists must live in Collier County, have a studio or business in Collier County, or be part of a co-operative or association that operates a business or gallery in Collier County.
- Artists must apply by the deadline which includes: a CV, an artist statement, a description explaining the submission, and up to six (6) images that can be considered. Only two images will be selected from one artist.
- The artwork can be made from any medium and should be completed works.
- The artists must agree to the final delivery dates for the images.
- An honorarium of \$500 will be awarded to each selected artist to cover time and use of the images for this purpose.
- Each selected artist should be available for interviews to promote the art on the notecards.

Application Process

Artists must complete the application. Most items are files that are to be included in the application package, and the application form is a listing of the files.

All images must be high-quality/high-res .pdf, .JPG, or .PNG files. File size should be a max of 10 MB, minimum 300 dpi at 7 inches in any direction.



The application includes:

- Application form – fillable pdf
- Artist CV
- Artist bio – 50 words or less (for the back of the notecards)
- Artist Statement
- Proposed images of at least 2 and up to 6 completed works

Application Submission

- A confirmation email will be sent when the submission is received.

- Approval and acceptance by Naples CVB juried panel and staff through a blind jury process
- The artist statement and piece description
- Fulfillment of the theme
- Design and composition
- Vision, creativity, and originality
- Technique and execution
- The cohesion of the two artists to showcase the theme and select art and artists showing a range of mediums.

Poster

Since ¡ARTE VIVA! celebrates Hispanic arts and culture for residents and visitors, it is fitting that we create a commemorative poster that addresses the cultural aspects of Hispanic arts and culture and celebrates the cultural activities of Florida's Paradise Coast. The poster will be used in advertising campaigns to promote ¡ARTE VIVA! and through possible merchandise opportunities. The types of merchandise are to be determined and can include giveaways and merchandise that is available for purchase. For merchandising purposes, the full poster or elements of the poster will be utilized in the various designs.

The physical poster size is 30 inches high and 20 inches wide. Designs should fit in a shape that is no larger than 20 inches high and 15 inches wide (a white border with the ¡ARTE VIVA! logo will be added to the final artwork to create the poster).

Design and Artwork

The design must be original work by the applicant and should be unique, and not include elements that could have been used in merchandise sold by the artist in the past. The artwork should represent the creative spirit, or the celebration of arts and culture, here in Collier County/Florida's Paradise Coast. It is recommended that a new piece of artwork be created for the poster.

The poster artwork can be any medium. If it is a 3D item, like a sculpture, then a photo of the artwork should be submitted.

The artwork design should not have the name ¡ARTE VIVA! in the artwork since it will be added to the final poster design in the border.



The original artwork will be needed for promotional events and activities between fall 2025 - spring 2026.

Eligibility

- The artist must live in Collier County, or have a studio or business in Collier County, or be part of a co-operative or association that operates a business or gallery in Collier County.
- The artist must be of Hispanic origin and 18 years old or older. Artists that have a majority of their work related to Hispanic culture and themes would be a secondary consideration.
- The artist must apply by the deadline which includes, a CV, an artist bio, an artist statement, a description of the submission and how it relates to Hispanic arts and culture, and the image to be considered.
- The artwork can be made from any medium, provided that a 2D image can be utilized in a poster.
- The artist must agree to the final delivery dates for the poster.
- An honorarium of \$2,500 will be awarded to the selected artist to cover time and use of the images for the promotion and merchandising of ¡ARTE VIVA!
- The artist should be available for interviews to promote the poster.
- The artist will receive a copy of any merchandise developed from the poster.

Application Process

Artists must complete the application. Most items are files that are to be included in the application package and the application form is mainly a listing of the files.

All images must be high-quality .pdf, .jpg, or .png files. File size should be a max of 10 MB, minimum 300 dpi at 7 inches in any direction.

Upon selection, the original artwork needs to be submitted so that it can be scanned to create the final poster image.

The application includes:

- Application form – fillable pdf



- Artist CV
- Artist bio – 300 words or less
- Artist Statement – how the poster design celebrates Hispanic arts and culture and represents Florida’s Paradise Coast
- Poster design
- If needed, a showcase of the artist’s work regarding Hispanic culture
