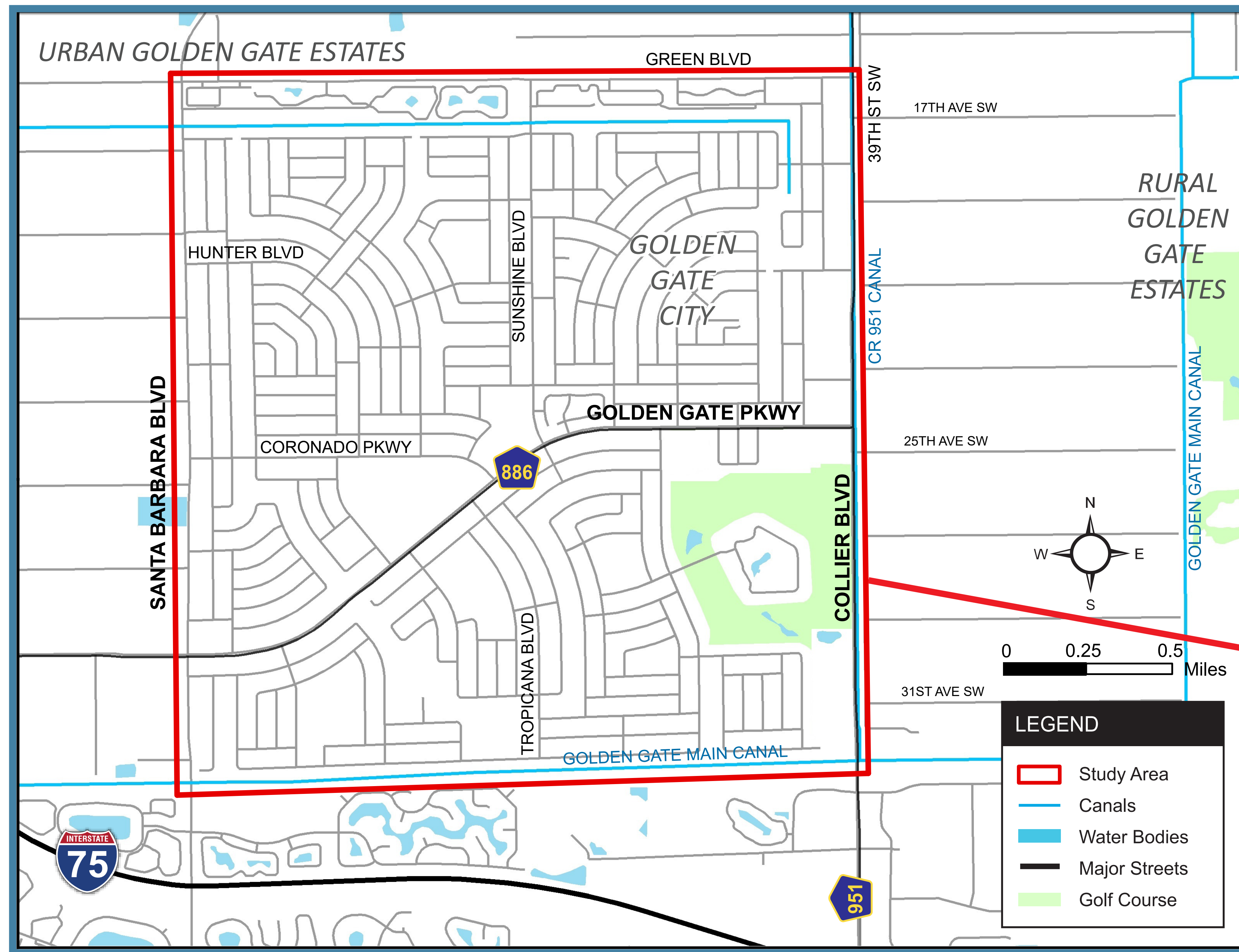

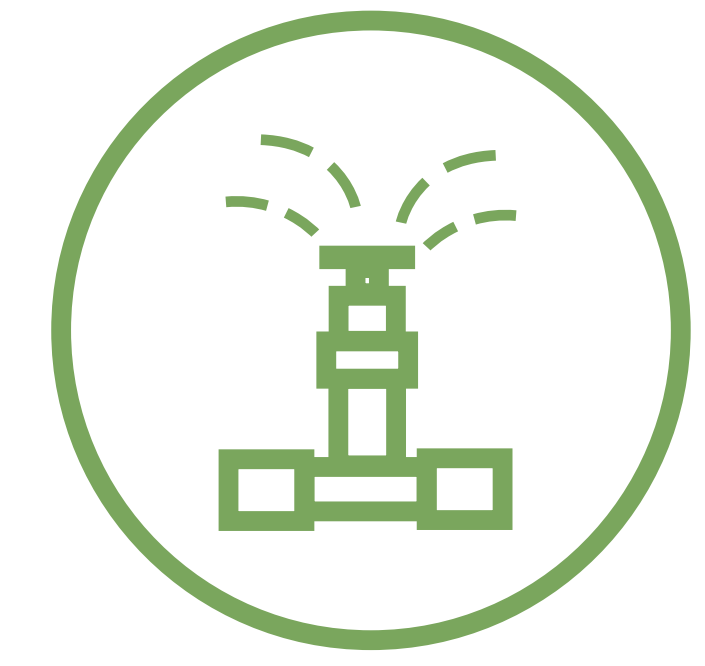

WHY IS A MASTER PLAN IMPORTANT?

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The Master Plan is necessary to coordinate a variety of improvements such as adding sidewalks and bike lanes, enhancing landscaping, upgrading drainage and stormwater systems, and improving pavement and street lighting.

This Master Plan will ensure that needs and improvements are coordinated to provide the necessary services in a cost-efficient manner and reduce potential impacts to the community during construction.



This Master Plan is a comprehensive, long-term (20+ year) strategy regarding infrastructure improvements in Golden Gate City. The infrastructure improvements are necessary to ensure reliable and efficient operations, anticipate future needs, and guide capital improvement investments.

This Master Plan will guide the county regarding future improvements, management of costs, and maintenance of existing and future infrastructure in the area.

- Landscaping

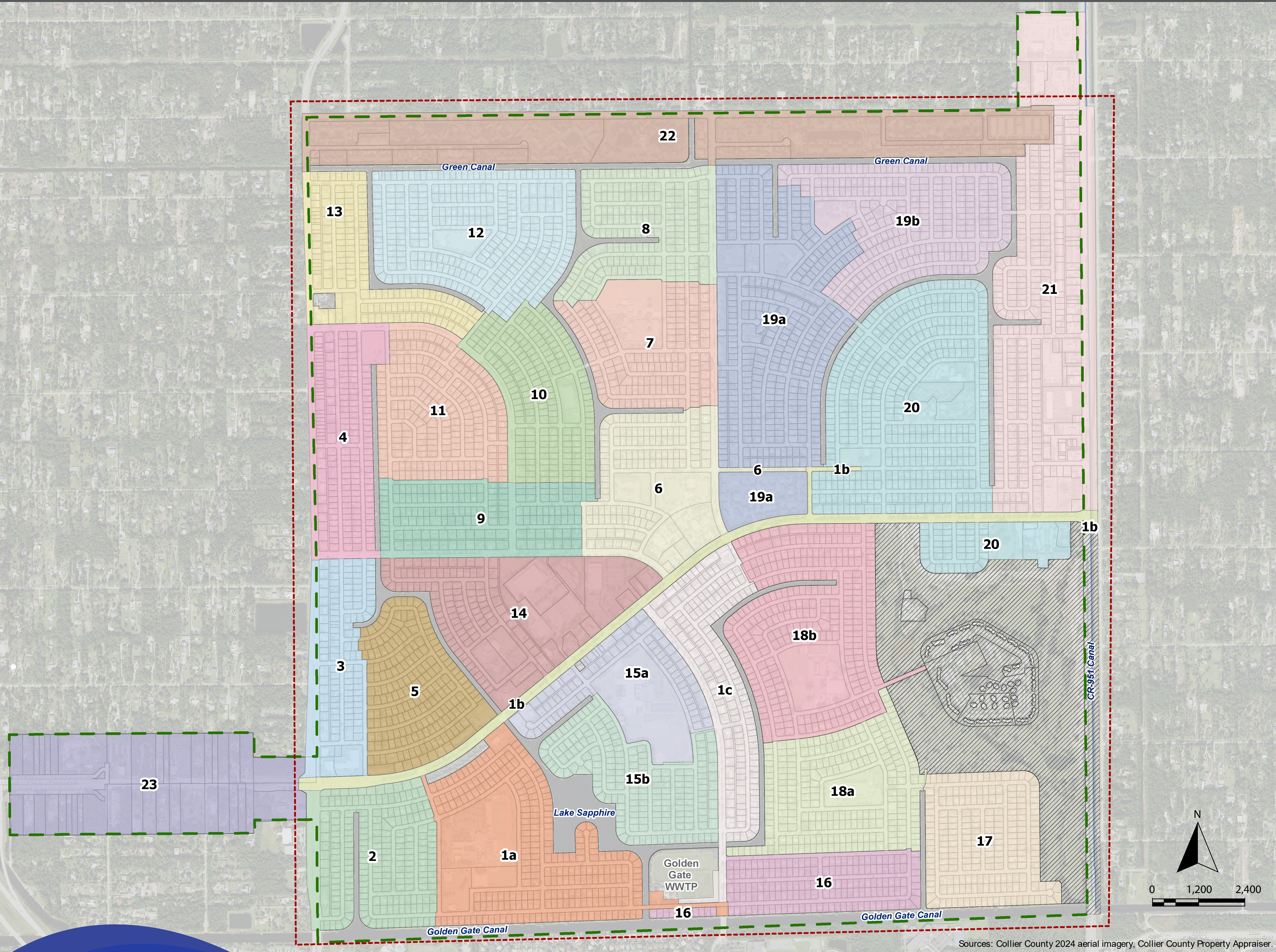


DEVELOP OVERALL PHASING PLAN



- **Collect and evaluate public comments**
Comments will be collected through February 3, 2026
- **Finalize the Master Plan and bring to the Board of County Commissioners (BCC) for approval**
- **Submit to the Florida Department of Environmental Protection**
Documentation for the grant Collier County was awarded to perform this study
- **Implementation based on funding**
Once adopted by the BCC, the Master Plan will become the guiding framework for future improvements and implementation over the next 20+ years
